



Payne CART Receives Grant

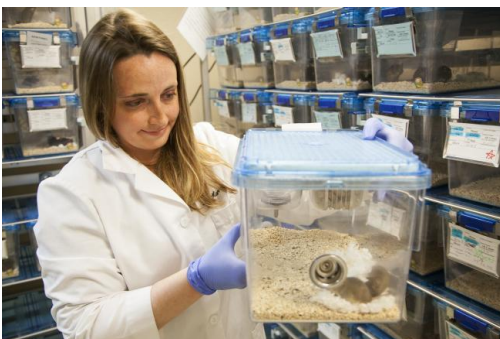
