Kip Lemke, DVM, MSc, DACVAA, is a professor of Anesthesiology and Pain Management. Originally from Normal, Ill., he earned his BSc (1981), DVM (1983) and MSc (1993) from the University of Illinois. He is also a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Anesthesia and Analgesia (1995). Lemke's research interests focus on neural blockade in dogs and balanced anesthesia in horses.

Lemke has earned the Pfizer Carl J. Norden Distinguished Teacher Award (2000) and the Pfizer Grant for Innovation in Teaching Methodology (2010). He was on the Board of Scientific Reviewers for the American Journal of Veterinary Research from 2002-2005. Lemke currently sits on the Editorial Board of Veterinary Anesthesia and Analgesia (2010-present) and has authored numerous scientific articles and book chapters on anesthesiology and pain management.

In his spare time, Kip enjoys skiing, surfing and fly fishing.
