EARLY ADMISSION PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY

- Enrolled as a full-time student in an Oklahoma four-year university
- Eligible applicants must have achieved an ACT score of at least 28 (SAT 1300 without writing portion)
- Must be able to demonstrate a strong interest in veterinary medicine, effective leadership and communication skills, emotional maturity, and other non-technical skills which reflect the knowledge and aptitude necessary for the successful practice of veterinary medicine
- Qualified applicants will participate in interviews as part of the selection process

APPLYING

- Apply as entering college freshmen (students who graduated high school in May)
- Upload your high school transcript and official college transcript showing any concurrent courses.
- Upload ACT or SAT scores. ACT Superscores are NOT accepted
- Two letters of reference are required. Letters of reference must be sent directly from the evaluator to dvm@okstate.edu
- Submit a \$50 application fee

The Early Admission application opens in August of each year for incoming freshmen.
