On behalf of the Oklahoma State University College of Veterinary Medicine, welcome to the 2023 OSU/OVMA Summer Seminar.

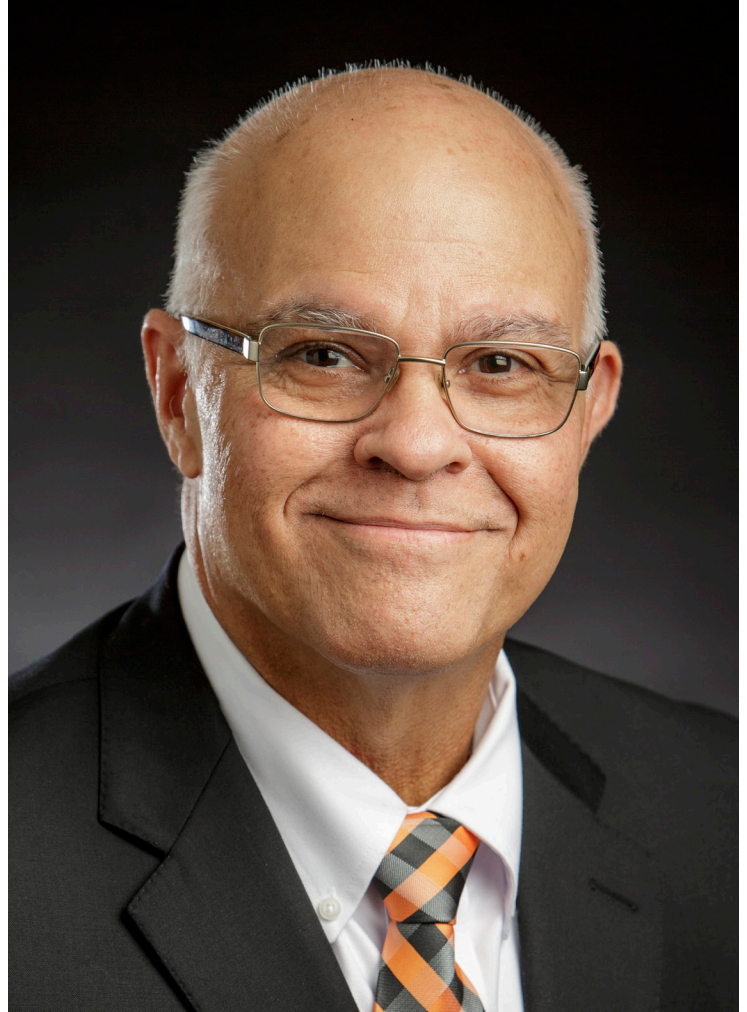
We have an informative, diverse program that I am certain will enhance your professional knowledge. We are glad you have chosen this event to receive your continuing education credits.

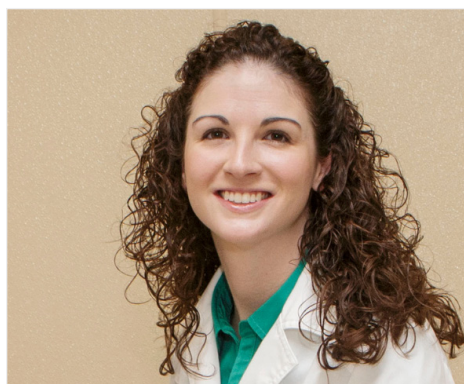
JULIANNE MCCREEDY
